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**Net Tuition Distribution Across LSAT Categories

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Scholarship Distribution for First-Years in the Classes of 2010 and 2014

With grant support from AccessLex Institute, I developed a dynamic net tuition model to estimate net tuition trends for first-years between 2010 and 2014.

The model put first-year students into six LSAT categories and six net tuition categories.

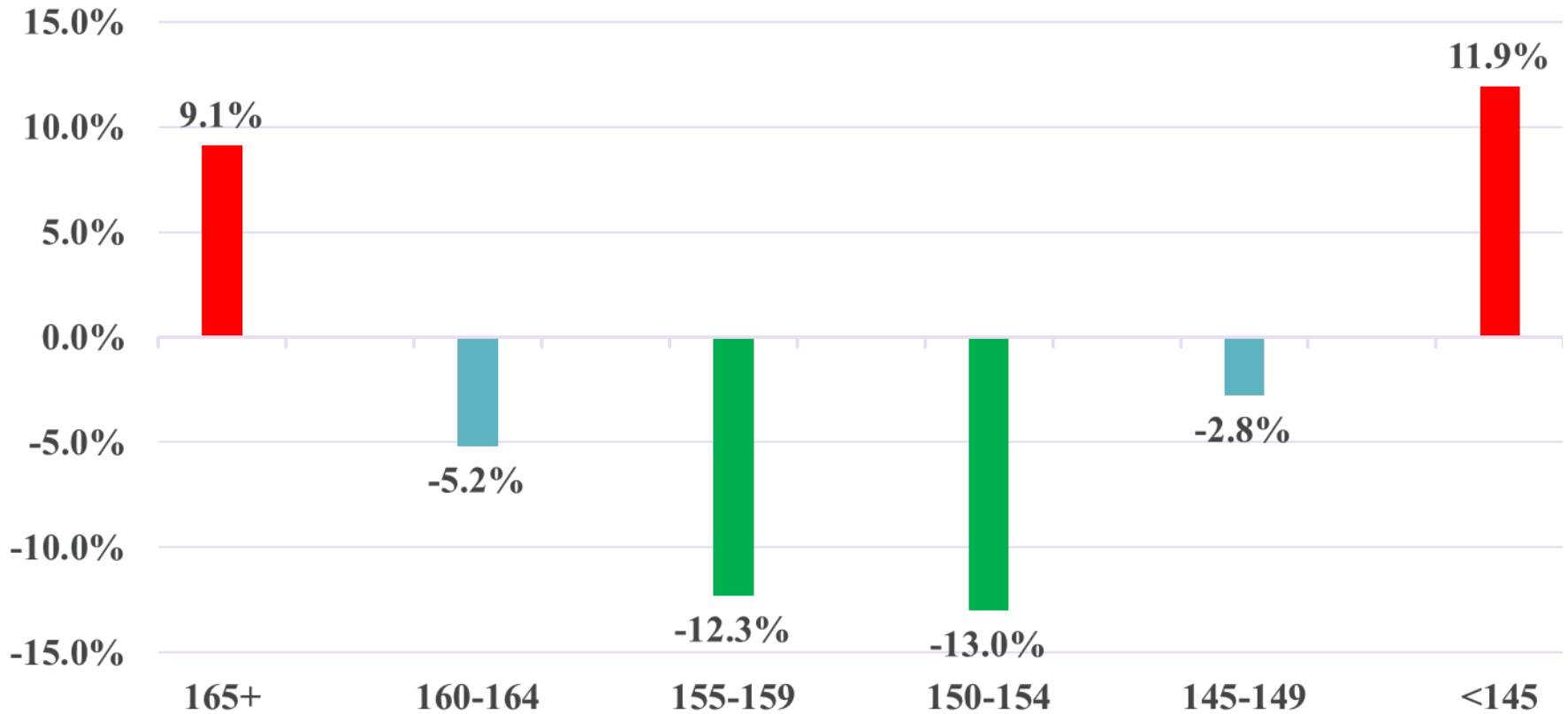
The model was really complicated and for those interested I have an article in the Journal of Legal Education in which I describe the model in detail and outline the results.

For these purposes I want to highlight just a few things that reinforce what Aaron Taylor has highlighted.

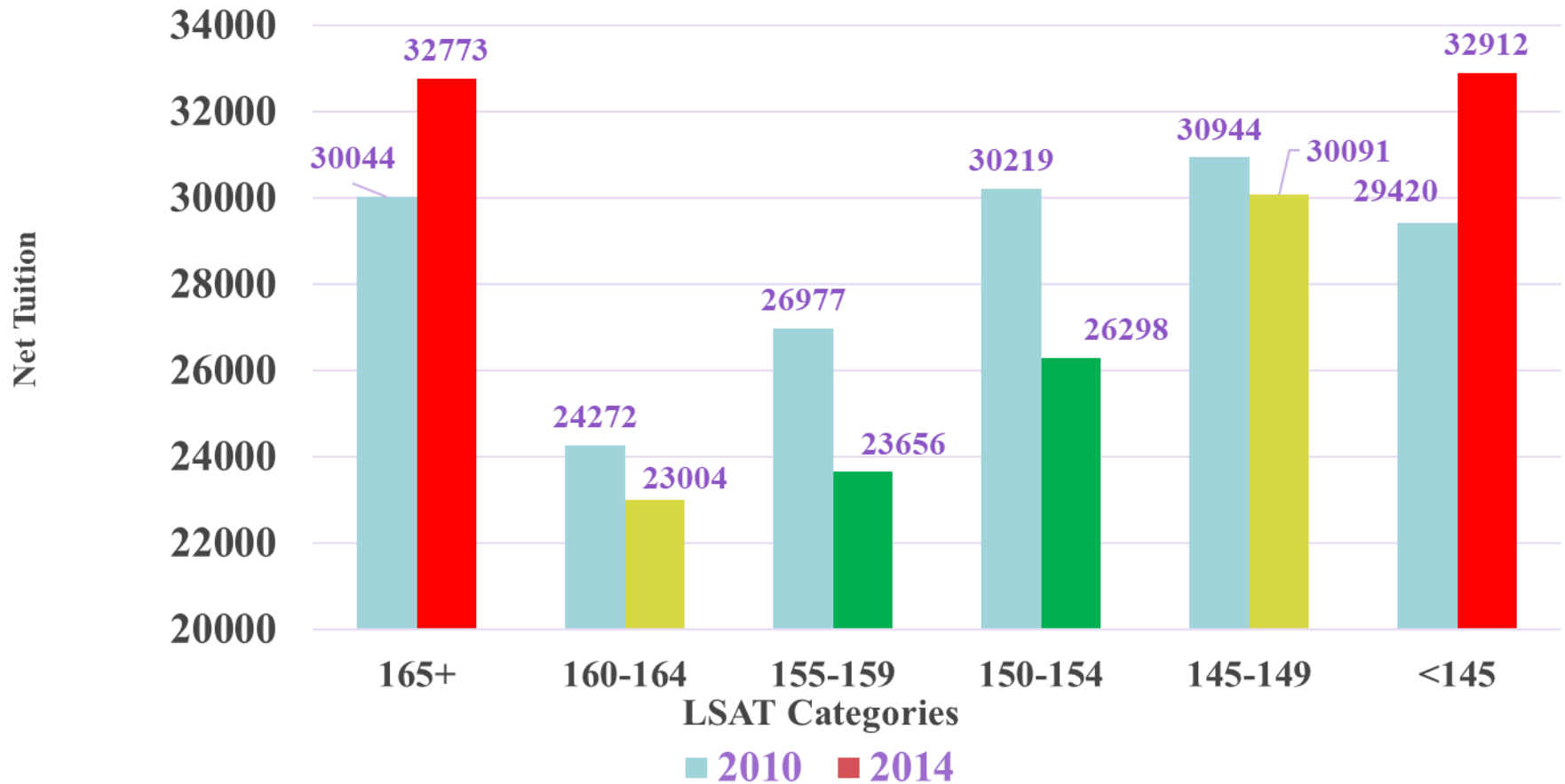

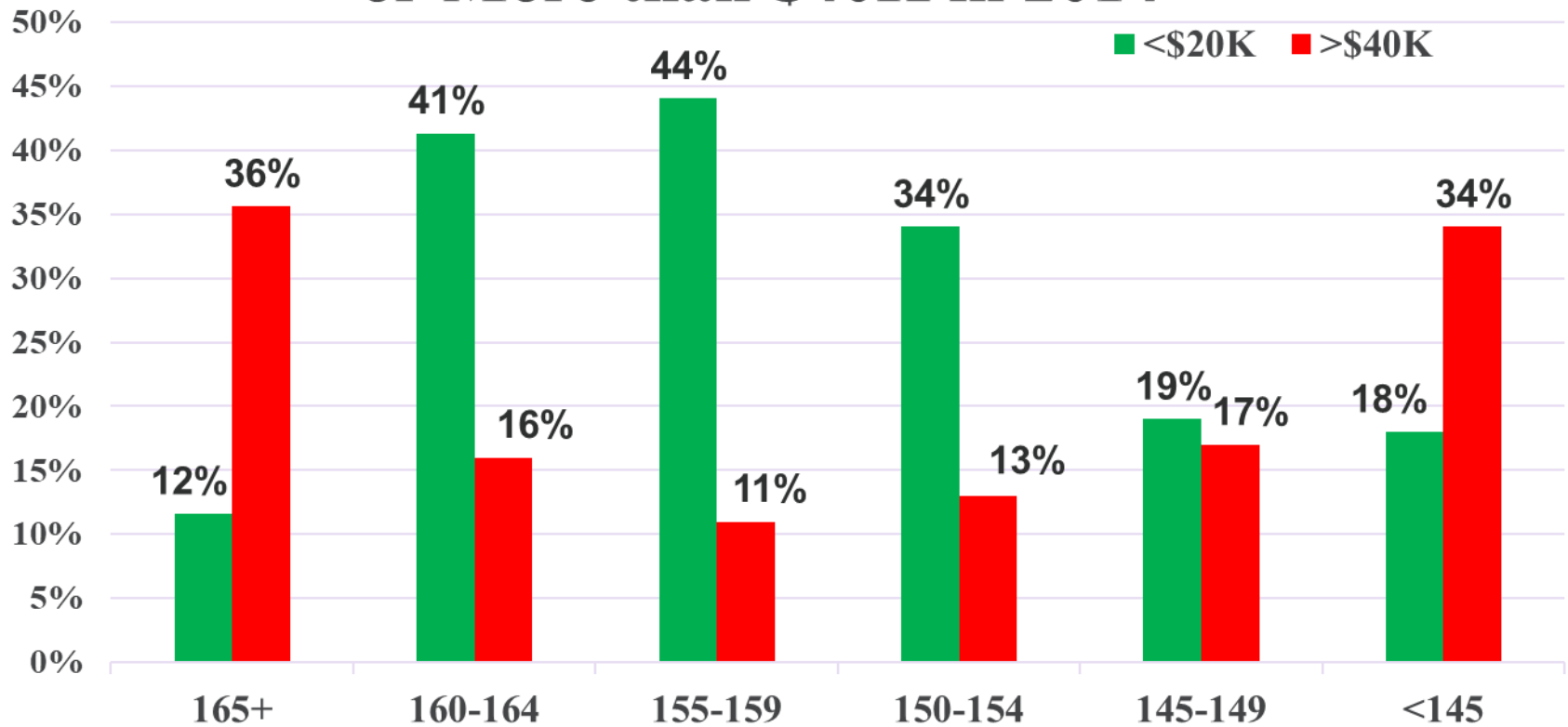
Percent Change in Average Net Tuition 2010-2014 by LSAT Category (in 2014 dollars)



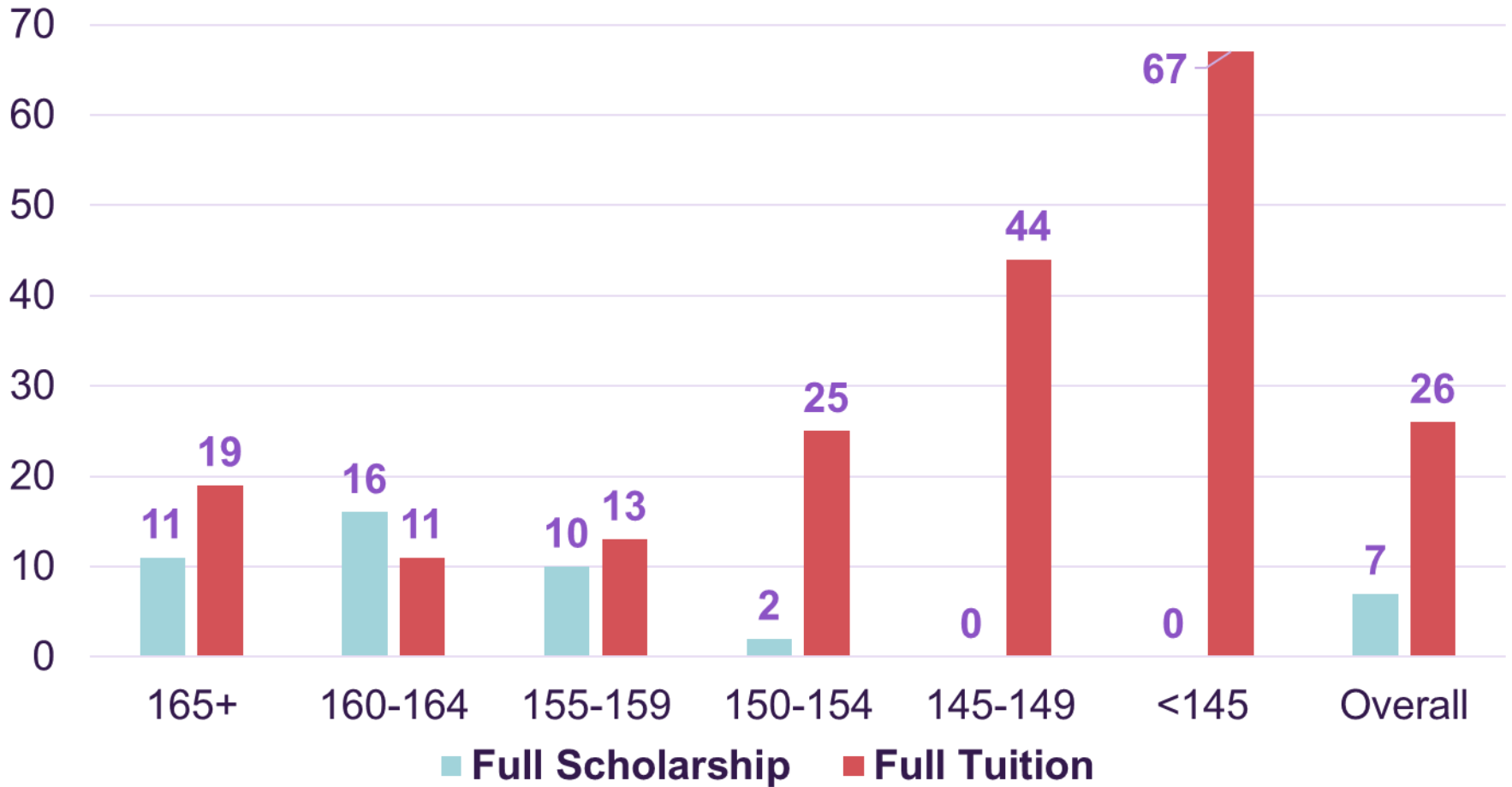
Comparison of Average Net Cost Trends by LSAT Category Between 2010 and 2014 (in 2014 dollars)



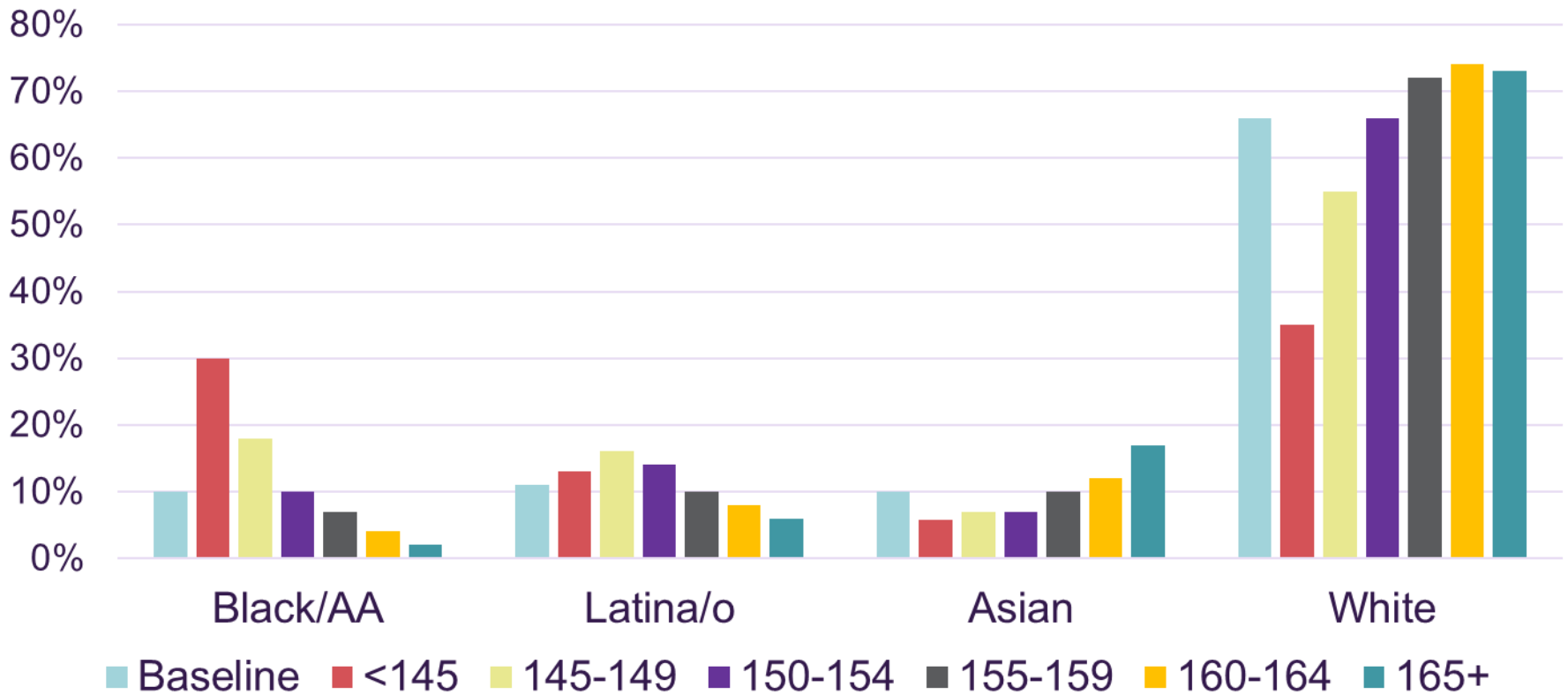
Percent of Students by LSAT Category with Average Net Tuition Less than \$20K or More than \$40K in 2014



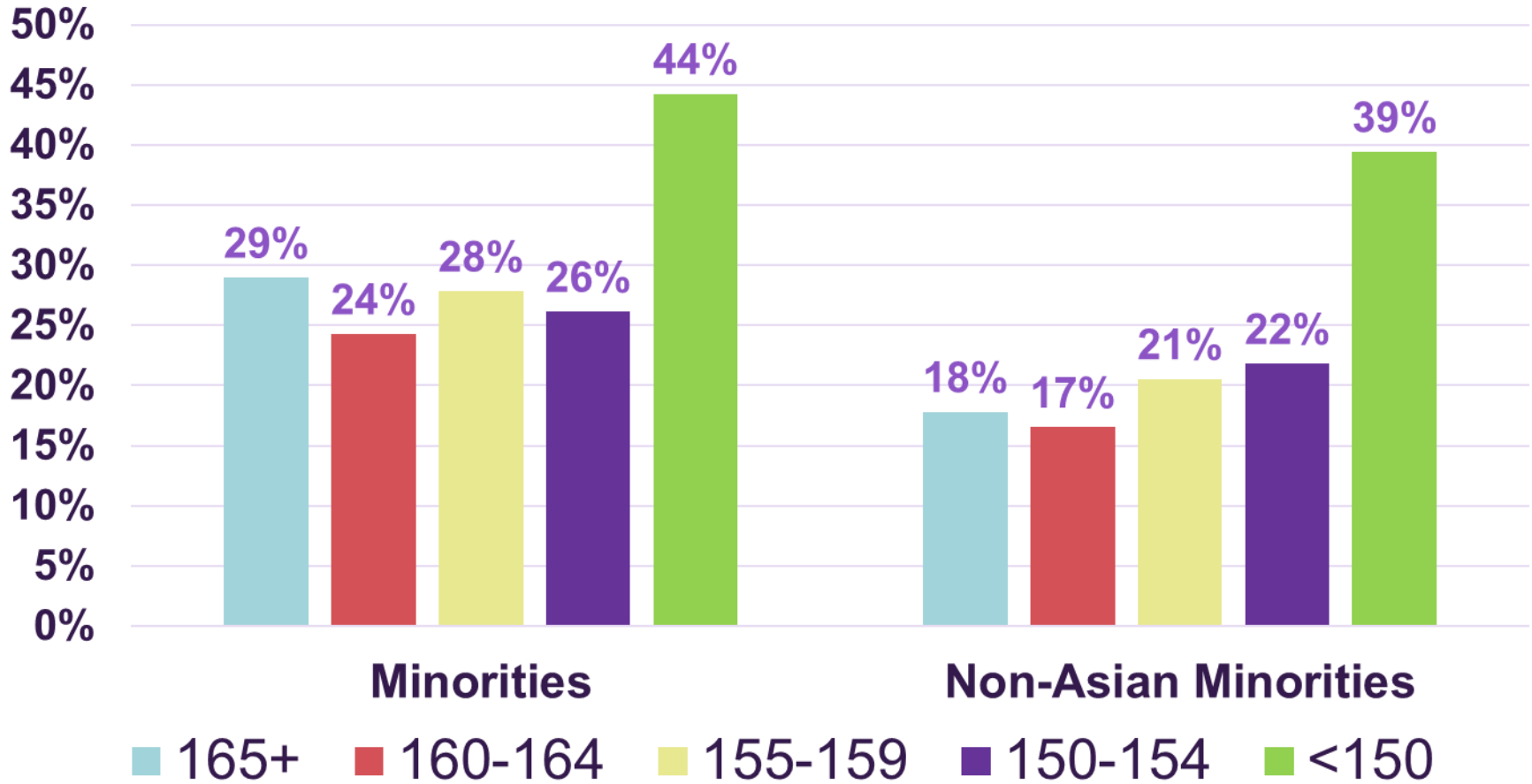
Percentage of Students Receiving 100% Scholarship or Paying 100% Tuition in 2014 by LSAT Category



2014 Minority Composition of Entering Class within LSAT Categories Among Law Schools with Full ABA Accreditation

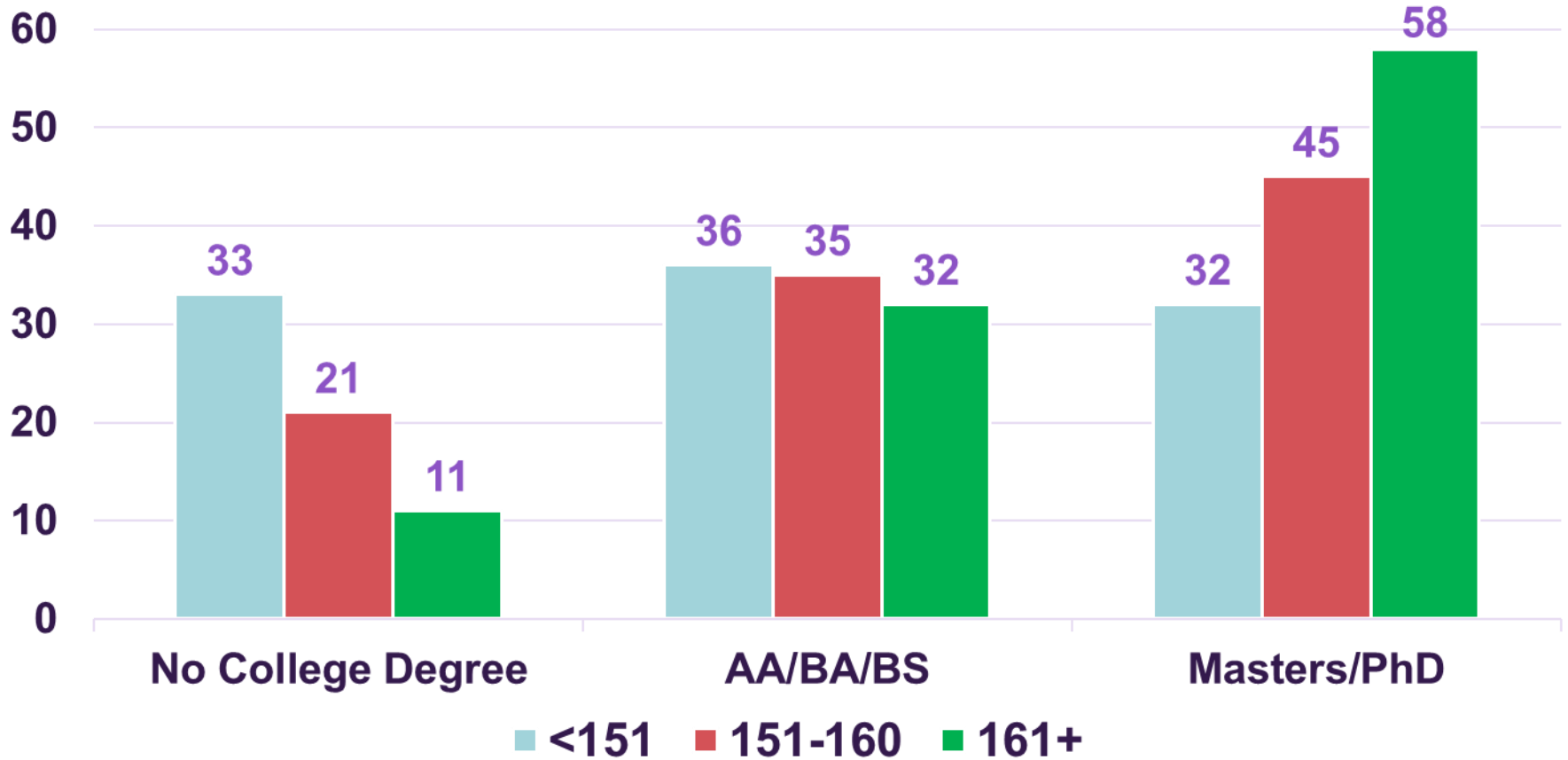


Minority Composition of 2014 Entering Class Across Law Schools Based on Median LSAT of Law Schools

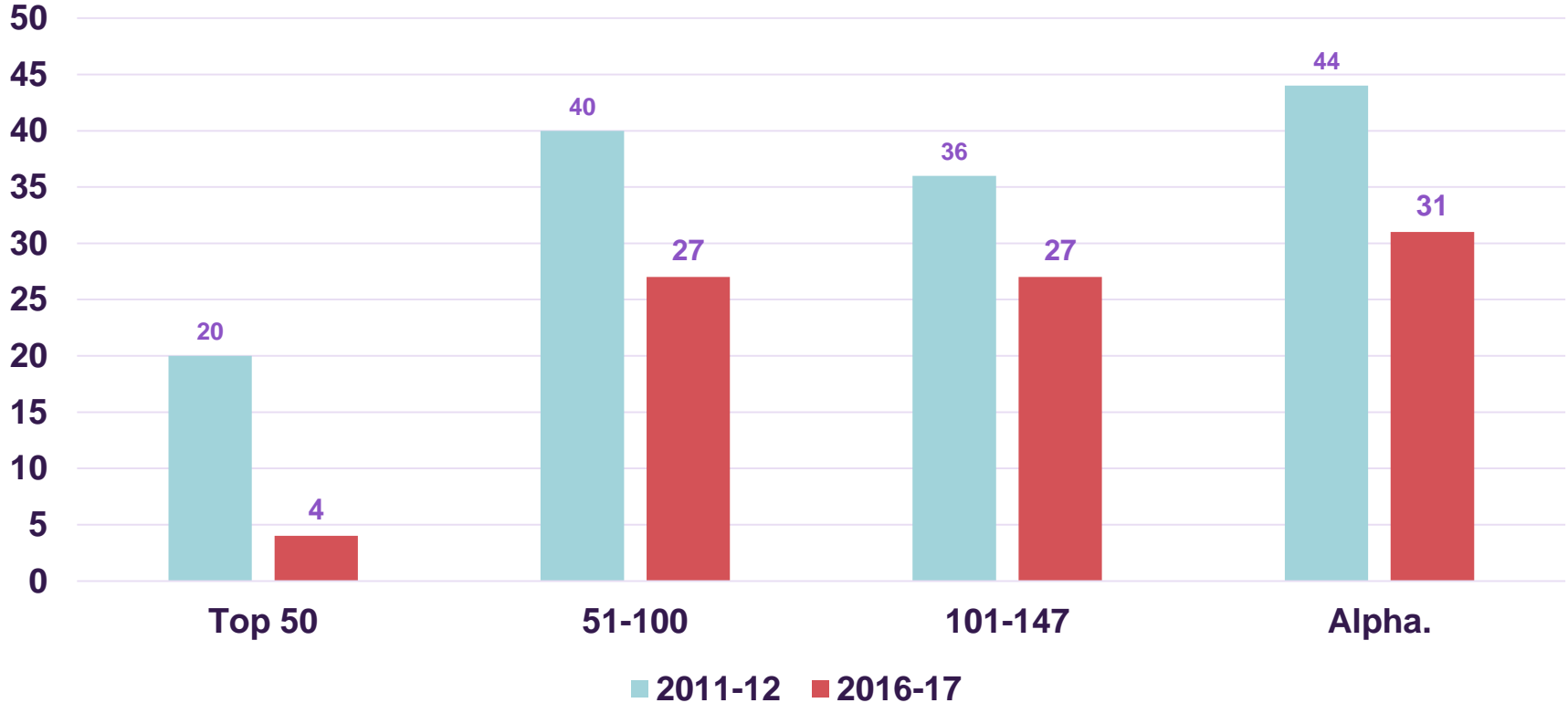

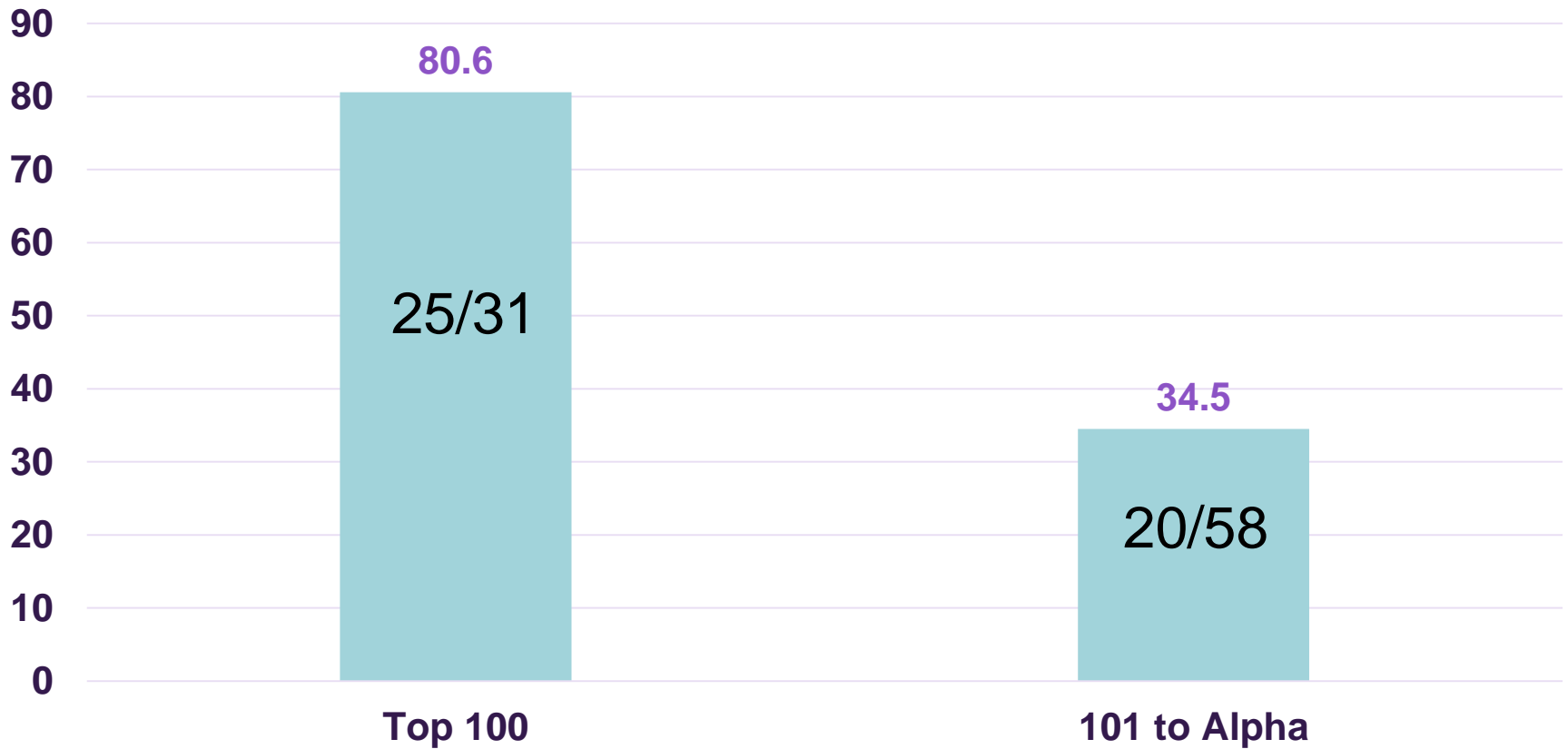
