AN ORDINANCE to amend the Wills and Probate Ordinances.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wills and Probate Short Title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1914.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in Section 27 of the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance (No. 1) the Administrator-General may take summary Summary prosecution of executor de son tort. proceedings under the provisions of Section 2 of the Wills and Probate (Amendment) Ordinance, 1912 at any time within five years from the time when the cause of complaint arose.

Passed in Council this Twenty-fifth day of March, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and fourteen.
