AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Ordinances, Nos. 9-1906 and 22-1910.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Ordinance, 1914. Short Title.

2. Section 13 of the Ordinance No. 9-1906 is amended by striking out the words "be required to give security in respect of each office" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "only be required to give security in a single amount in respect of the offices for which he is responsible, unless the Governor, in any particular case, orders him to give security in respect of each such office." Amendment of Section 13 of Ordinance 9-1906.

3. The amendment made by this Ordinance shall have retrospective effect, and Section 13 of Ordinance No. 9-1906 shall be read as if the words inserted therein by the preceding Section hereof had been inserted in the said Section Amendment retrospective.
