AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Tariff Ordinance, 1912.

BE it enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Saint Lucia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Tariff Ordinance, 1912, Amendment Ordinance, 1915 (No. 3), and shall be read and construed as one with the Customs Tariff Ordinance, 1912, hereinafter called the principal Ordinance.

Addition to Second Schedule to No. 1 of 1912.

2. There shall be added between the second and third paragraphs of the Second Schedule to the principal Ordinance the following:—

“Bags, sacks, and barrels for shipping produce.”
