AN ORDINANCE to make provision for defraying the Expenses of the Government of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the year from 1st April 1914, to 31st March, 1915.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. There may be issued and paid from and out of the Public Moneys of the Colony of Trinidad and Tobago for the service of the year from 1st April 1914, to 31st March 1915, an amount not exceeding the following sums, that is to say:—
