AN ORDINANCE to amend the Savings Bank Ordinance, 1903.

[30th December, 1913.]

BE it enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Saint Lucia, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Savings Bank Ordinance, 1903, Amendment Ordinance, 1913. Short title.

- Addition to section 6 (2) of No. 14 of 1903. 2. The following proviso shall be added to subsection two of section six of the Savings Bank Ordinance, 1903 :—
“ Provided that the sum on deposit on account of a registered Friendly Society may amount to, but shall not exceed, four hundred pounds.”
- Addition to section 10 (4) of No. 14 of 1903. 3. The following proviso shall be added to subsection four of section ten of the Savings Bank Ordinance, 1903 :—
“ Provided that interest shall accrue on any sum on deposit on account of a registered Friendly Society which does not exceed two hundred pounds.”
- Addition to section 25 of No. 14 of 1903. 4. The following paragraph shall be added to section twenty-five of the Savings Bank Ordinance, 1903 :—
“ ‘Registered Friendly Society’ means a Friendly Society duly registered in accordance with the provisions of the Friendly Societies Ordinance, 1896, or any Ordinance amending or substituted for the same.”
