AN ORDINANCE to amend the Corporal Punishment Ordinance, No. 107.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Corporal Punishment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1914. Short Title.
- 2. No sentence of flogging or whipping shall be passed upon any female. Corporal Punishment not to be inflicted on female.
- 3. Sub-section (3) of Section 4 of the Corporal Punishment Ordinance (No. 107) is hereby repealed. Repeal.
- 4. In line 2 of Section 7 of the Corporal Punishment Ordinance (No. 107) in lieu of " 14 " shall be read " 16. " Amendment of Section 7 of Ordinance 107.
