AN ORDINANCE to apply the Imperial Army Act to Volunteers serving with the Imperial Forces.

[ 28th August, 1915. ]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Saint Lucia, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Volunteer Ordinance, 1915, and shall be construed as one with the Volunteer Ordinance, 1907, No. 5 of 1907.

Volunteers voluntarily serving out of the Colony deemed part of the Regular Forces.

2. All officers of the Volunteer Force of this Colony and all volunteers voluntarily serving with the Imperial Forces out of the Colony, or on their way from the Colony for the purpose of so serving, or on their way back to the Colony after so serving, shall be subject to the Army Act in all respects as if they were part of His Majesty's Regular Forces.
